Watch for Ё was derived from E, and for a long stretch of its history the two were not held apart at all: before 1942 Ё was usually considered a modification of E rather than a separate letter. The only thing separating them on the page is the mark above, and that mark is optional. After the 1942 decree, typographic practice reverted to using Ё selectively, to show the pronunciation of rare words and to separate words that would otherwise be homographs, and by 1952 it had been declared optional outright. Treat a bare e in a word that takes ё as that word; a missing mark is not evidence of a different word.
